In addition, there are administrators on duty in the service centers of each dormitory. If there are any emergencies, dormitory students can contact the service center. In addition, teachers and students living in the dormitory on-campus and off-campus dormitories are requested to pay attention to the typhoon at any time, try not to go out, and pay attention to the following:

1. Check whether the doors and windows of the house are firm? Will there be water seepage inside?
2. Check whether the drain holes on the roof and balcony are blocked, and whether the drainage ditch outside the house is unblocked?
3. Check whether the outdoor potted plants and hanging objects need to be moved indoors to avoid falling damage or hitting people.
4. Prevention of power outages - Are flashlights and batteries ready?
5. Avoid lack of food - whether dry food, bread, mineral water are prepared?
6. Prevention of flooding and landslides - If the residence is located in a low-lying area or near a hillside, you should temporarily take refuge in a safe place.
7. Beware of accidents - it is dangerous when there is heavy wind and heavy rain, so don't go out.
8. Check the latest typhoon news - pay attention to radio and weather reports.
